Our unique facility is located one block from Lechmere station on the Green Line in an historic building with a gallery space, which is available for 2D fine arts exhibitions from all disciplines, with a multicultural perspective and focus.

- no fee if accepted as an exhibiting artist, although we strongly encourage artists to become Multicultural Arts members
- artists maintain 75% commission on artwork sold, with 25% going to support events/programs at the Multicultural Arts Center
- assistance with press and promotional efforts by our staff, including listing of events on all of our promotional materials (exhibition postcard, website, monthly newsletters, and a press release)
- proposals accepted from both individuals and group

PROPOSALS

Please follow submission requirements listed below. Any incomplete proposals will not be if your proposal is not selected, we do not discuss reasons for declining proposals. Mailed/mailed submissions considered only. We *do not* conduct interviews/in-person portfolio reviews.

With your proposal, please include:

- Statement of Purpose: Please include a brief description of your proposed project's content and how it relates to our mission, what you intend accomplish and the timeline needed.
- Resume and/or Artist's Bio
- Examples of 2D work: Accepted formats include prints, photographs, cd, dvd, links to online photos or clips, etc.
- Return of materials: If you would like your materials to be returned to you, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your proposal.
